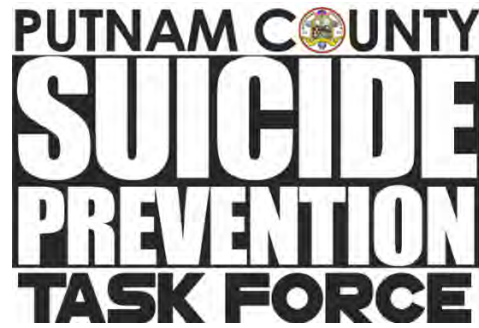

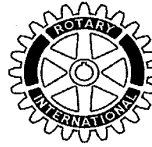

**IMPORTANT: You May be One of the Over 46,000  
Consumers Eligible for a CASH Refund from Harris
