

PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE

This is professional nursing work involving assessment of health needs, development of plan of care, and provision of health/wellness education for individuals and families.

Responsibilities include periodic re evaluation of individual and family as well as support of community nursing needs. Work may be performed at patients' homes or in clinic settings. Special work duty outside of normal work hours (such as on holidays or weekends) may be required. Work is performed under general supervision of higher-level Health Department staff. Performs related work as required.

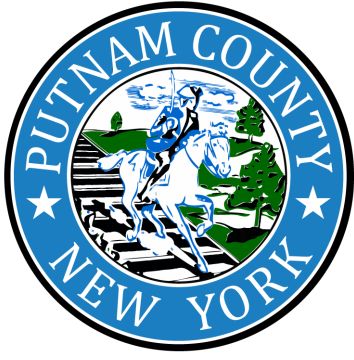

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: *

Bachelor's degree in nursing

PLEASE NOTE: Education beyond the secondary level must be from an institution accredited or recognized by the Board of Regents of the New York State Department of Education as a post secondary, degree-granting institution.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Possession of a valid license and current registration to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse in New York State are required at time of appointment and must be maintained throughout employment.
2. Possession of a valid, unrestricted, appropriate level driver's license, and acceptable driving record are required at time of appointment and must be maintained throughout employment.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR SPANISH-SPEAKING SPECIFIC POSITIONS:

1. Candidates must be fluent in speaking, reading, writing and translating Spanish.
2. There is an oral Spanish proficiency examination.
