

SPECIAL PATROL OFFICER

This position involves responsibility for maintaining order and providing security in and around public buildings, school district buildings, courtrooms and/or other public facilities. Incumbents have all the powers of a peace officer, as set forth in §2.20 of Criminal Procedure Law, when performing the duties of protecting property or persons in and around such premises. Work is performed under general supervision of the County Sheriff, or of the appointing authority. Performs related work as required.

This is a Competitive position. Applicants must be a retired member of a police or sheriff's department, or of a division of state police, or retired former correction, parole or probation officer.

SPECIAL PATROL OFFICER



MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be a retired member of a police or sheriff's department, or of a division of state police, or retired former correction, parole or probation officer.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS REGARDING POSSESSION OF FIREARMS:

Special Patrol Officers may not carry or possess firearms while on duty unless authorized to do so by the appointing authority. If so authorized, possession of a license issued pursuant to §400.00 of Penal Law (Criminal Procedure Law §2.10.37) is required. Where possession of license is required, eligibility for and possession of the license is required at the time of, and throughout, appointment.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT*: Special Patrol Officers are Public Officers, therefore, New York State residency in Putnam County, or a contiguous county to Putnam (Dutchess, Orange, Rockland, Westchester), is required at time of appointment and throughout employment.
