Board of Electrical Examiners Application Process for Obtaining a Putnam County ELECTRICAL JOURNEYMAN License - STEP 1

There are three steps involved in the process of becoming an Electrical Journeyman in Putnam County.

First, the Electrical Board must review your application.

- Complete and sign the enclosed application.
- Provide Proof of Employment Form Filled out by employer.
- Complete Experience Worksheet.
- Provide proof of 5 years' experience in the electrical trade. Proof can be in the form of:
 - w-2 tax forms
 - Social Security statements
 - Notarized letter from employer(s) documenting number of hours worked and itemizing residential and commercial experience
- Resume See attached list of requirements for the type of electrical work to include in your resume.
- Provide a copy of your driver's license. If the address on your license does not match the address on the application include proof of home address (i.e. Utility bill or bank statement).
- Application fee is \$150 Provide check or money order made payable to **Commissioner of Finance**. We do not accept cash. You can pay with a credit card in person at the office.

Second, once the application has been approved by the Electrical Board, you will be notified by email regarding how to register for the Electrical Journeyman exam. The exam must be passed with a score of 75 or higher. The testing fee should be paid directly to the test provider.

Third, once you have passed the test you are eligible to apply for the Putnam County Electrical Journeyman License. The license fee is \$100.

- To maintain your Electrical Journeyman License, you are required to renew every 2 years.
- You must take a continuing education course every year and provide certificates of completion with your renewal application.
- You must hold your license for a minimum of two years before being permitted to shelve.
- You must renew or shelve your license every two years, or you will forfeit your license and will be required to retest.
- You must be a Putnam County Electrical Journeyman before you can test for the Master license.

The above process can take between three to six months. Fees are subject to change.
