

As you are aware, the Committee met over the course of several months and presented their conclusions which reflected several options for my consideration. I selected the option that I felt was considered reasonable, fiscally informed, fair and regionally competitive which also gave full consideration to the taxpayers as well as the dedicated Putnam County employees. I then presented this final recommendation to all four unions represented in Putnam County (CSEA, PBA, PCSEA, and PuMA).

After meeting with the four unions and their representatives, agreements have been reached regarding revised employee health-insurance contributions.








**Employee Insurance Contribution Rates** Regional Comparison of Range
