RE: Report of the Budget & Finance Committee on the 2026 Tentative Budget

Dear Madam Clerk:

The Putnam County Budget & Finance Committee has completed its review of the 2026 Putnam County Budget. Pursuant to Section 7.04 B (3) of the Putnam County Charter, I hereby submit this report to you from the Budget & Finance Committee.

The Committee has completed its review of the 2026 Tentative Budget as submitted by the County Executive to the Legislature on October 1, 2025. The County Executive presented the Tentative Budget to the Budget & Finance Committee on Wednesday, October 1, 2025. As explained in the County Executive's presentation, the 2026 Executive Budget has kept the Property Tax Levy flat. It was further presented as interest rates skyrocketed the decision to use the capital reserve funds to finance major projects instead of relying on costly borrowing was made. That decision, as reported, continues to save millions related to future interest payments and is accounted for in the tentative 2026 Budget. Additionally, it maintains the county's strong financial condition, which reflects positively on the county's AA1 bond rating from Moody's. Immediately following the County Executive's presentation, the Budget & Finance Committee held a Public Hearing.

Commencing on October 6, 2025, the Tentative Budget was reviewed by the appropriate Legislative Committees. Input was received from the Administration, Department Heads and County Elected Officials. Each Committee then submitted its proposed revisions and adjustments to the Budget & Finance Committee for additional review and approval on October 20, 2025. The modifications that were approved by the Budget & Finance Committee are outlined in the attached "Schedule A".

Upon recommendation of the Health, Social, Educational & Environmental Committee, the Budget & Finance Committee moved the Office of Senior Resources Copier Chargebacks to the correct budget line.

The Rules, Enactments & Intergovernmental Relations Committee (Rules Committee) proposed an increase in the Putnam Arts Council lines by a total of \$4,043 bringing the County Contribution to their requested amount of \$75,000. The Rules Committee proposed an increase in County Contribution for the Second Chance Foods and Putnam Recreation Programs.

The Budget and Finance Committee further increased County Contribution lines for Career Support Solutions, Hudson Valley Shakespeare, Garrison Arts Center, and Boscobel.

The Personnel Committee approved restoring salaries to the requested amount for several positions as specified in the attached Schedule A. The Personnel Committee also approved a salary increase to specified positions per the Catapult Executive Consulting Company Salary Survey (Catapult Survey). As a reference, the Catapult Survey was presented to the members of the Legislature at the September 18, 2025, Personnel Committee Meeting. The Budget & Finance Committee approved these requests.

During the Budget & Finance Committee meeting, Legislator Jonke proposed a "Homeowner Tax Relief Rebate". After discussion and consultation with County Attorney Abissi the title was amended and approved to be "Homeowner Tax Relief Program". Attorney Abissi advised a program such as this would require a collaboration of many, beginning with the County Executive. Legislator Jonke stated that he agreed with Attorney Abissi and appealed to the County Executive to join the Legislature to make this happen. The Budget and Finance Committee approved this request, moving \$6,500,000 from Fund Balance to Subcontingency.

The Budget & Finance Committee also made a few minor adjustments at the request of the Administration to properly reflect accounts as information became available to them.

The entire budget process ran smoothly, and although the Budget & Finance Committee made slight changes as outlined in the attached "Schedule A," a fiscally sound budget has been compiled through the combined efforts between the Administration and the Legislature. The County Executive's proposed 2026 Tentative Budget kept the real property tax increase within the New York State Tax Cap. The resulting budget will also allow the County to continue to provide the necessary services and programs to meet the health, safety and welfare needs of the Putnam County residents.
