

Evaluate Policies for Climate Resilience

- Evaluation of existing plans, policies, and projects to:
 - Expose gaps and vulnerabilities
 - Help ensure past policies will either help, reduce, or, at a minimum, not increase vulnerability
 - Stimulate ideas and collaboration among local government staff and officials

What is Climate Vulnerability?

Vulnerability

Vulnerability: The degree to which physical, biological, and socioeconomic systems are susceptible to and unable to cope with adverse impacts of climate change (SOCCR2, 2018). Generally, systems that are sensitive to climate conditions and less able to adapt to changes are considered to be vulnerable to climate change impacts.

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Adaptation

In human systems, the process of adjustment to actual or expected climate and its effects to moderate harm or exploit beneficial opportunities. In natural systems, the process of adjustment to actual climate and its effects; human intervention may facilitate adjustment to expected climate and its effects (IPCC 2022).

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Resilience

The capacity of interconnected social, economic and ecological systems to cope with a hazardous event, trend or disturbance, responding or reorganizing in ways that **maintain their essential function, identity and structure.** Resilience is a positive attribute when it **maintains capacity for adapting learning and or/transformation** (IPCC 2022)







Step 1: What hazards are relevant to Putnam County?

Climate Summary

Extreme heat, severe storms, flooding







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Step 2 & 3: What hazards are relevant & what is at risk? Community Infrastructure, Socio-Economic, Natural/Working Lands Exposure, Sensitivity, Adaptive Capacity







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Step 5: How do stakeholders prioritize hazards, assets & vulnerabilities?

Conduct outreach and engagement events





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Step 8: How often should the plan be updated? How? At least every 10 yrs
