Simulated Impaired Driving Experience (SIDNE)

SIDNE is a behind the wheel driving experience that simulates what happens when a driver attempts to operate a vehicle while impaired or distracted. 9/11 Youth-Led Memorial

The Putnam County Youth Bureau and Haldane School District join countless organizations across America to remember the 2,983 women, men, and children who lost their lives on September 11th, 2001, while also recognizing those who have passed since then as the result of their heroic efforts in the aftermath of this tragedy. Youth entrepreneurs, ages five to seventeen (accompanied by parents and/or guardians), come together to sell their homemade crafts, food, collectibles, and services to guests who visit the market. This event provides valuable business and marketing learning experience for youth from Putnam and nearby counties.
